

# Blackbridge Jubilee Athletics Track

## Conditions of Use

### 1. Health and Safety

1.1 All athletics training and competition must be subject to UK Athletics health and safety guidance at;

All training and competitions must be conducted as per the UKA Approved Code of Practice at;

1.2 Coaches (and individual athletes whilst training independently) must satisfy themselves that any equipment used is fit for purpose. Damaged equipment must not be used and should be set aside and reported on (see Damaged Equipment Reporting Form). No liability will be accepted by the Company for any injury sustained during the use of faulty, damaged or inappropriate equipment.

1.3 In the event of injury a report must be made to the Company on the appropriate form (see Accident/Incident Reporting Form)

1.4 Users must satisfy themselves that adequate first aid provision is in place.

1.5 Equipment must be stored away safely after use in its place of origin.

1.6 No electrical equipment may be used without express consent.

1.7 No smoking is allowed anywhere within the track fence line.

### 2. Use of Equipment

2.1 Equipment and implements may only be used for their intended use, checked for safety (as above) and returned to their proper place after use.

2.2 Covers on the High Jump, Pole Vault and Long Jump beds must be replaced properly after use. The area around the Long/Triple jump pit must be swept of sand. All divots from heavy throws must be replaced and those areas rolled weekly.

2.3 The inside lane of the track is subject to disproportionate wear and tear and should not normally be used in training sessions. In the event of conflict of use on the track the following etiquette is expected;

Lane one – no training use

Lanes two and three – distance and middle distance training

Lanes four, five and six – sprinting

Lanes seven and eight – hurdling

### **3. Track Access**

3.1 Access to the track is via the Podsmead Road entrance. Cars, Vans and light Coaches can access the car park at this location. Trucks and full size Coaches may not enter here. Passengers may be dropped off at the entrance and alternative parking sought.

### **4. Payment**

4.1 The appropriate track fee must be paid before use. If the payment site on admission is not obvious, individuals must seek out the appropriate person, pay the correct fee and collect and retain a ticket.

4.2 The admission ticket may be inspected at any time by any person approved by the Company. Users found not to be in possession of a ticket on request may be asked to leave the facility.

4.3 The above will not apply during the course of competitions as it is the responsibility of the competition organisers to ensure that appropriate payment is made.

### **5. Hiring Charges**

5.1 The appropriate hiring fee is expected to be paid on booking.
